The meeting ended at 7:50pm with a Dua led by Barrister KA Shikdar MBE.

Executive Committee and Advisory Council Meetings:

The Executive Committee (EC) and Advisory Council (AC) met twelve times during 2019 to 2022. According to the agenda, the details of the meetings were recorded in the minutes.

The first EC&AC meeting was held on 27th October 2019 at Harford Multicenter, 115 Harford Street, London, E1 4FG. Twenty-three members were present. According to the main agenda, the present members provided very positive feedback about the last Special General Meeting (SGM) which was held on 8th September 2019. Two main agendas were in the meeting: 'Future Kanaighat Association' and 'Youth involvement'. Two sub-committees were formed in the meeting:

1. One sub-committee was nominated to expand KAUK branches in the other cities of UK. Sub-committee members are Mr. Nazirul Islam, Mr. Anisul Hoque, Mr Abul Fatah, Mr Mokhlisur Rahman, Mr Ahmed Iqbal Chowdhury, Mr Faruk Ahmed Chowdhury, Mr Harun Rashid, Mr Sulaman Ahmed.
2. The second sub-committee was nominated to involve our youth. The subcommittee members are: Mr Zakaria Siddique, Mr Nurul Alom, and Mr Reazul Karim.

The second EC&AC meeting was held on Sunday 26th January 2020 at Harford Multicenter, 115 Harford Street, London, E1 4FG. Agenda was the same as the previous EC meeting. All members advised the sub-committees to take necessary steps to expand KAUK branches in other cities.

The third EC&AC meeting was held virtually on Friday 25th December 2020. After almost one year, all EC members attended virtually on Zoom. The main agenda was to update the previous year's charity activities.

The fourth EC&AC meeting was held virtually on Sunday 4th April 2020. There were two main agenda items: the Ramadan Program and fund raising for Kanaighat College Mosque. It was agreed to arrange a virtual Eid gathering after Ramadan. Everyone agreed to raise fund for Kanaighat College Mosque. A sub-committee was formed to raise the mosque fund. Members are: Mr Nazirul Islam, Mr Anisul Hoque, Mr Mokhlisur Rahman, Mr Ahmed Iqbal Chowdhury, Mr Zakaria Siddique, Mr Faruk Ahmed Chowdhury, Mr Harun Rashid, Mr Mashuk Rabbani, Mr Salik Ahmed and Mr Noman Ahmed.

The fifth EC&AC meeting was held on Sunday 18th July 2021 at Bow Muslim Cultural Centre, London, E3 3AP. Twenty members attended. According to the main agenda, every member unanimously agreed that the Biannual General Meeting and the election should be held on 29th August 2021. The election commissioners

are: Maulana Abu Sayeed, Al Haj Mokhlisur Rahman, Mr Serajul Islam, Barrister Kutub Uddin Ahmed Shikdar MBE, Md Ijrat Ullah, Mr Sadequl Amin and Mr Siraj Uddin.

Mr Bashirul Islam was included as KAUK Advisor in the meeting. Everyone agreed to arrange a family gathering, for which a sub-committee was formed. The next EC&AC meeting was held on Sunday 22nd August 2021 during the journey to Camber Sands. The main agenda was to postpone the BGM due to the pandemic and extend the current executive committee for another one year. All members agreed and advised to arrange a SGM to discuss the agenda further.

Special General Meeting

A Special General Meeting (SGM) was held virtually via ZOOM on 19th September 2021. Everyone agreed to extend the current committee for another year.

The next EC&AC meeting was held on 9th January 2022. Main agenda was Ramadan Quran distribution project, which everyone agreed. A sub- committee was formed. The next EC&AC meeting was held on 18th May 2022 virtually via ZOOM. Agenda was Flood Appeal. It was decided to arrange an Emergency General Meeting immediately.

Emergency General Meeting:

The Emergency General Meeting was held on 22nd May at Bow Muslim Cultural Center, London, E3 3AP. Agenda was raising funds for flood victims. Imam Abul Husain Khan outlined how to succeed at the Channels Live Appeal on 25th May 2022. A sub-committee was formed for flood collection. Next EC&AC meeting was held on 22nd May at Bow Muslim Cultural Center, London, E3 3AP. Main agenda was BGM and Family Gathering. The date for the Family Gathering was fixed for 11th September 2022, and BGM date 2nd October 2022.

It was also decided to launch a website for KAUK. Responsibilities were given to Mr Sadequl Amin, Mr Mahbubur Rahman Shamim, Mr Mokhlisur Rahman and Mr Ahmed Iqbal Chowdhury.

Next EC&AC meeting was held on 20th June 2022. Main agenda was to discuss how to distribute the flood collected funds.

The final EC&AC meeting was held on 28th of August 2022. Main agenda was to finalize the Family Gathering program.

Sub-Committee Meetings:

Hundreds of sub-committee meetings were held over the last three years to organize all the social and humanitarian projects. Every sub-committee member worked extremely hard to deliver all the projects on time.

Social and Humanity Activities:

- A Dua Mahfil was held on Monday 26th August 2019 at Bow Muslim Cultural Centre, 246 Bow Road, London, E3 3AP. This Dua Mahfil was arranged for the deceased mother of secretary Mr Mokhlisur Rahman and parents of Mr Mujibur Rahman. About 30-40 members participated in the mehfil. The Dua was led by Maulana Rafique Ahmed.
- On 26th January 2020, scholarship money was awarded to the children of late Monowar Badrudduza of Baiyompur Sador Union. Moulana Rafique Ahmed, Mr Nazirul Islam, Mr Ajmol Ali, Mr Mokhlisur Rahman, Mr Ahmed Iqbal Chowdhury and Mr Zakaria Siddique were present in the program.
- On 23rd February, a dua mahfil was organized virtually following the death of the mother of KAUK ex-secretary Mr Shuabur Rahman. Many Kanaighatis attended to express their sympathies and condolences. Maulana Abdur Rahman Madani led the dua.
- On 4th March 2020, KAUK donated money to widow Sufia Begum of village- Dorjimati, to assist the build of her house. Money was handed by Hafiz Moulana Altafur Rahman
- The Covid-19 pandemic affected all the countries in the world, including our homeland Bangladesh. Many suffered during lockdown. KAUK distributed substantial cash amongst the unfortunate people of Kanaighat. Within 90 wards of Kanaighat Upojela, cash was distributed in the month of May 2021. Two thousand five hundred people benefited. Upojela Chairman, UNO, Union Chairmen, and many honorable persons attended the programs. Mr Anisul Hoque, Mr Faruk Ahmed Chowdhury and Mr Harun Rashid were involved with the Chairperson, Secretary and Treasurer to organize this mega project. Many in Bangladesh also got involved and worked tirelessly to deliver the project throughout the Kanaighat Upojela. Every Kanaighati living in the UK donated for this noble cause. May Allah reward everyone abundantly for their donation and hard work.
- On 2nd June 2020, KAUK raised money for Mrs Jamila Begum of village- Narainpur, Gasbari for her tumor treatment. Chairperson, Mr Nazirul Islam, overlooked the process.

- On 8th June 2020, KAUK raised fund for the treatment of Moulana Abdul Wadud Sahed of Talbari, Rajagong Union, who was suffering from kidney disease. Mr Mujibur Rahman, Mr Faruk Ahmed, Mr Harun Rashid and Mr Sulaman Ahmed handed over the cash amount to his nephew Mr Abu Saleh Yahya.
- Channel S took initiative to feed 5000 people in Bangladesh during lockdown. They donated £2000 to KAUK to distribute in Kanaighat Uopjela. On 16th June 2020, Mr Mokhlisur Rahman, Mr Faruk Ahmed Chowdhury and Mr Harun Ahmed received the amount from Channel S Studio. KAUK officials added some extra money to make total to 2 lac 44 thousand taka. Relief was distributed at two points in Kanaighat. On 4th of July 2020, Mr Mashud Ahmed and Mr Imam Chowdhury were present as guests in Gasbari Madrasa venue. Upojela Chairman, Mr Abdul Munim Chowdhury, Moulana Abul Hussain Chatuli were guest in Kanaighat venue. Channel S Sylhet representative Mr Moinuddin Mojo also attended.
- On 7th July 2020, KAUK donated cash to Haratoil Mahila Madrasa of Union 5 Borchotul to refurbish the Madrasa. The money was given to principal Moulana Abul Hussain Chatuli.
- On 25th September 2020, KAUK raised cash for the treatment of Hafiz Abdul Munim Javed of village-Batoi Shail of Sador Union. Mr Masud Ahmed Chairman was the chief guest at the distribution program held on 9th November 2020.
- Kanaighat Association UK raised cash for the orphan of Mr Abadur Rahman, village – Chotropur, 7 No. Dokkhin, Banigram Union. On 2nd November 2020, KAUK handed over the money to Mr Seraj Uddin at his home in East London. Moulana Rafique Ahmed, Mr Ijrat Ullah, Mr Mokhlisur Rahman and Mr Faruk Ahmed were present in the meeting.
- A virtual ‘Get together’ ZOOM meeting was held on 3rd January 2021. Lots of Kanaighatis attended the program and enjoyed the get-together in this difficult time by reciting Holy Quran, exchanging views, singing songs and gazals.
- On 31st January 2021, KAUK arranged a virtual reception to Mr Eahsane Elahi following his promotion to the rank of full Secretary. Many Kanaighatis from all over the world attended this historic reception program. Overwhelmed with emotion, Secretary of Labour and Employment Mr Elahi termed this event as an International Seminar. He thanked Kanaighat Association for arranging this prestigious program.
- On 7th February 2021, a Virtual Open Cultural program was organized for the children. Quran recitation, nasheeds and songs were performed by our children. Everyone was mesmerized by their talent.
- On 2nd February 2020 and 2nd March 2021, KAUK donated some cash to Haji Abdul Khalique Mohila Madrasa. Hafiz Moulana Altafur Rahman handed the cash on behalf of KAUK.
- During the holy month of Ramadan 2021, a virtual meeting was organized to understand the significance of Ramadan. Maulana Rafique Ahmed, Moulana Kutub Uddin Ahmed Shikdar MBE, and Khatib of East London Mosque Abul Husain Khan were guest in the program.
- On 8th May 2021, former president and advisor of KAUK, Barrister Kutub Uddin Ahmed Shikdar MBE, handed over the check to the authority of Kanaighat Govt Degree College for the construction of the mosque they are building in the college campus.

- A virtual Eid gathering was organized on 16th May 2021. Many Kanaighatis from UK and abroad participated in the program. Recitations, speeches, nasheeds and reminiscences of the past made the program successful.
- A day trip to Cumber Sands beach was organized on 2nd August 2021. Over 50 people attended and enjoyed the variety of activities on the way to and from London, and on the beach.
- Honorable Barrister Kutub Uddin Ahmed Shikder MBE received the award 'Freedom of the City of London'. A grand reception was organized on 3rd October 2021 at Regent Lake Banqueting Hall. The presence of large number of Kanaighatis took the event to a unique height.
- In the month of Ramadan 2022, KAUK distributed a large number of Holy Quran copies among the 86 Hafizi Madrasa of Kanaighat. The distribution of this Quran among the students studying Hafizi in the month of revelation of the holy Quran was appreciated by all.
- The last humanitarian project of this session was the 'relief and cash distribution' to the flood affected people of Kanaighat. Our beloved land, Kanaighat, was affected by the terrible flood of the century. Honorable Khatib of East London Mosque, Shaikh Abul Hussain Khan, called for unity to stand by the people affected by flood. A substantial amount was raised through KAUK WhatsApp group, Mosque appeals, and live charity appeal on Channel S on 25th May 2022. This appeal raised the biggest amount in the history of Kanaighat Association UK. Total raised money was distributed in the form of relief, cooked food, and cash among the people in the 90 wards of Kanaighat Upojela and various flood shelters.

Family Gathering:

Annual Family Gathering of Kanaighat Association UK was held on 11th September 2022, with the determination to strengthen the unity of brotherly bond among the Kanaighatis residing in UK. Large number of Kanaighati families attended this gathering. Twenty-nine of our talented youngsters were awarded certificates to recognize their GCSE and A-level achievements.

Press and Publicity:

Each social and humanitarian activity of KAUK was published on its Facebook page and in the electronic media. A magazine named 'Jagoron' was published in the event of Family Gathering 11th of September 2022.

Lastly, after thanking Almighty Allah and my family for their endless support, I would like to thank all Kanaighatis who supported KAUK and inspired me over the last three years. Their contribution and generosity have been crucial in pulling together the most comprehensive projects in KAUK history; I am truly humbled.

I would like to also thank the key members in the UK and in Bangladesh who have stepped-up to take the vital roles to make the collection and distribution possible. I am particularly grateful to Mr Sadequl Amin for his guidance, reviews, and recommendations throughout my time as Secretary.

I feel very blessed and honoured to have served as Secretary between 2019 – 2022. May Allah help us all.
